#### **Team Roles**

Over the past few years the role of the Team Manager has developed and proven to be a great success for each of the regions. This role assists each of the regions by having a main point of contact at the event who will also be responsible for registering their gymnasts and in turn reducing the congestion at the British Gymnastics Accreditation Desk. Team Managers will be based at the regional desks near the gymnasts and coaches' entrance (Entrance E) and will be given a list of the gymnasts attending orientation to register (as attending) and also competing (by flight) each day to and accredit upon arrival for their competition. Coaches are required to report to the British Gymnastics Accreditation Desk, located to the right of the regional desks and register. Team Managers should work with the appointed Team Chaperone(s) to deliver the gymnasts by flight, to the Warm-Up Hall at the times detailed on the competition schedule and notify the Accreditation Desk of any withdrawals. This is a very important role and will greatly assist with the smooth running of the competition.

To ensure and manage the accreditation effectively, please ensure gymnasts are informed to arrive in time for the registration 'slot' detailed on the timetable for their flight.

Please note, it is crucial that only the gymnasts on the list are accredited, as the Team Managers will be issued with the exact number of wristbands required for each day. In addition, it's imperative that at the end of each flight registration time each time manager needs to go to the registration desk to confirm all gymnasts have registered and notify the registration desk of any gymnast withdrawals, to prevent North from being charged a non-participation fee as stated in the Trampoline, Tumbling and DMT Competition Handbook 2024.

#### Duties:

- To enure the regional desk, located at the gymnast and coaches entrace is maned from the start of orientation training on Friday until the last flight has registered on Sunday
- Ensure gymnasts, prior to arrival at the venue know which region they are representing
- Register gymnasts on arrival for both orientation training and competition each day
- Distribute gymnast's accreditations once registered on the day of competition
- Inform the Team Chaperone(s) of gymnasts who have been registered and if there are any withdrawals, which need to be submitted to the British Gymnastics Accreditation Desk
- Liaise with the Team Chaperone(s) to ensure all gymnasts are met upon arrival at the main gymnast entrance 'E'. Following accreditation / registration the chapereones are required to ensure gymnasts are taken to the Warm-Up Hall in readiness for their allocated flight.
- Ensure after the gymnasts have completed their competition, the Chaperone(s) are taken to the 'Gymnast Collection Area' located at concurse level, using the stairs located oppsite the warm-up hall, this will be clearly signposted.

Please note the Team Manager and Chaperone will only be permitted to access the gymnast / coach's entrance and Warm-Up Hall, not the Field of Play.

Where this role is fulfilled by different people over the weekend, the Team Manager's accreditation should be handed back to the British Gymnastics Accreditation Desk, and the new official will need to collect upon arrival.

#### **Team Chaperones**

The role of the Team Chaperones is to liaise and support the Team Manager.

#### **Duties:**

- To arrange collection of gymnasts from the gymnast and coaches entrance and lead them to the Warm-Up Hall, where their coaches from the region will be located (route can be shown in **Appendix 1**)
- To deliver gymnasts back to their responsible adults / guardians after they have complted their competition agreed location which will be signposted
- To inform the Accreditation Desk of all withdrawals / changes to teams

Please note the Team Chaperones will only be permitted to access the gymnast / coaches entrance and Warm-Up Hall, not the Field of Play.

Where this role is fulfilled by different people over the weekend, the Team Chaperone's accreditation must be handed back to the British Gymanstics Accreditation Desk, and the new official will need to collect upon arrival.



## Coaches

Please find below a list of coaches from your region.

Coaches will be required to report to the British Gymnastics Accreditation Desk upon arrival to collect their accreditation. Should a coach arrive who is not on the list below, the coach is required to go to the team manager to approve if the said coach can be added. The team manager is required to report to the Accreditation Desk so we can carry out the necessary checks to allow the coach to be added.

Please note, accredited coaches will have access to both the Warm-Up Hall and Field of Play, however the following coach ratio will apply:

TRA: 8 coaches (4 FOP & 4 Warm-Up Hall)
TUM: 8 coaches (4 FOP & 4 Warm-Up Hall)
DMT: 6 coaches (3 FOP & 3 Warm-Up Hall)

#### Parents & Spectators

Responsible adults / guardians are required to arrive and transfer responsibility to the Regional Team Chaperone at the gymnasts and coaches entrance (Entrance E) and then proceed to use the designated spectator entrance (Entrance F) for orientation training and on days of competition. When gymnasts have finished competing, responsible adults / guardians are required to meet gymnasts on the concourse by block 2 where there will be an area cornered off, not at the regional desks. The Team Chaperone will lead gymnasts back to their responsible adult / guardians. This is to prevent the area where the regional desks are located from becoming too congested, and ensure this area is only accessed by accredited persons.

## **Venue Information**

#### Address

## Car Parking

Pay and display car parking is available at the venue on the North car park. Alternative car parking is available nearby.

## Gymnast & Coaches Entrance

For orientation training and on the days of competition, gymnasts and coaches are required to use the designated entrance signposted as **Entrance E** (see diagram in **Appendix 2**) and report to the regional desk to be signed in.

## Spectator Entrance

For orientation training and on the days of competition, spectators are required to use the designated spectator entrance, signposted as **Entrance F** (see diagram in **Appendix 2**).

#### Regional Desks

Each region will be allocated a desk located in the foyer area located at the gymnasts and coaches entrance (Entrance E). This desk will be manned by the Team Manager who will register gymnasts upon arrival. Coaches are required to report to the British Gymnastics Accreditation Desk, also located in the foyer area to the right of the regional desks, to register.



#### **Accreditation Desk**

The British Gymnastics Accreditation Desk will be located in the foyer area of the gymnasts and coaches entrance, to the right of the regional desks.

This desk will be used for the following:

- Coach's registration and accreditation
- For each regional Team Chaperone to inform British Gymnastics of gymnast's registrations and withdrawals by flight
- To hand in each region's orientation training sheet confirming who is in attendance
- Submission of tariff sheets
- Any queries regarding the event

#### Warm-Up Hall

Gymnasts must not use the equipment in the Warm-Up Hall without a qualified coach present and must respect their scheduled time as per the timetable.

## Regional Areas

Each region will be allocated an area of the Warm-Up Hall for their teams to congregate. Please see the diagram in **Appendix 3** for details. Please respect this request and stick to the areas provided for ease of gymnasts finding coaches and vice versa.

### **Gymnast and Coaches Seating**

Accredited gymnasts and coaches who wish to watch the competition may sit in the allocated delegation seating (Blocks 2 & 11). Please respect this request and do not sit in any other area during the competition.

If a gymnast/coach wishes to spectate on the day they are not competing, they will be required to report to the Accreditation Desk, to collect a Coloured paper wristband, this will then be swaped for there silicon band on the day they compete by the Team Manager,

# **Orientation Training - To Follow**

Orientation training will take place on Friday evening for gymnasts competing on Saturday, and Saturday evening for those competing on Sunday. Gymnasts and coaches should report to the regional desks at the gymnasts and coaches entrance on arrival to be signed in. Spectators are required to use the designated spectator entrance (entrance 'F').

Training is scheduled by region, please see below for the timetable.

It is the responsibility of the Team Manager to register gymnasts for orientation training, and the Team Chaperone to notify the Accreditation Desk of any gymnasts who are not on site for health and safety reasons. Coaches should report to the Accreditation Desk to sign in for orientation training.

It is advised that the Team Manager contacts the individual clubs within your region prior to the event to enquire as to whether they are attending training. A hard copy of these lists will be available at the event.

Orientation Training Schedule - NB: Please refer to the orientation schedule attached separately

Entry to stretching area will be 30 mins before warm up in training hall commences

#### **Timetable**

The Team Manager and Team Chaperone should adhere to the timings listed on the competition timetable, and ensure gymnasts are not present in the warm-up hall earlier than stated.

NB: As per previous events the competition will run up to 60 minutes ahead of schedule, if possible, therefore please ensure your gymnasts are on-site should this occur.

Following the above statement, it is important that the competition timings are followed. Should clarification be needed, please enquire at the Accreditation Desk.

# **Catering**


There will be catering outlets open at the venue throughout the weekend, including during orientation training. Alternatively, spectators are welcome to bring packed lunches and snacks.

# Appendix 1 - Route to Warm-Up Hall



# Appendix 2 – Gymnasts, Coaches & Spectator Entrances

Gymnasts and coaches are required to use **Entrance E**, on the lower level and spectators must use **Entrance F**, on the upper level. **Entrance F** is also where gymnasts will meet parents/spectators after competing.





# Appendix 3 – Regional Areas
